

BUBBA'S LOST PHLOCK CLUB-TICKET ELIGIBILITY POLICY
EFFECTIVE BEGINNING W/ THE 2003 CONCERT SEASON
REVISED WEDNESDAY, MAY 08, 2002

Given:

- There is no guarantee that Jimmy Buffett will perform a concert tour in a given year.
- Should there be a concert tour, there is no guarantee that BLPH or any other PHiP affiliated Club will be offered the privilege of obtaining Club Group Seating Tickets for a concert.
- Guidelines of PHiP prevail in any dispute or conflict between Club Policy and PHiP Policy.

BLPH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Any BLPH club member wishing to purchase a club ticket **MUST** meet Eligibility Requirements 2, 3, and 4 below.
2. A) The member must be in good standing with BLPH for **a period of six (6) months as of January 1st of the given concert year.**
OR
B) The member must be in good standing with BLPH and **have met the annual BLPH Activities and Events eligibility criteria as of January 1st of the given concert year [Requirement 4].**
[DETAILS: **Example** – For the 2003 JB concert, any BLPH member in good standing who:
A) joins BLPH by or before July 1, 2002; **OR**
B) joins after July 1, 2002 yet are able to meet Eligibility Requirement 4 by the end of December of 2002.]
3. No person with BLPH Dues in arrears may be eligible to purchase Club Tickets.
[DETAILS: BLPH dues must be paid no later than January 31st of the given year.]
4. Ticket eligibility for a given concert year will be determined by participation in BLPH club activities and events during the prior calendar year, as described under **PARTICIPATION IN BLPH ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.**
5. Members earn eligibility for **one** ticket per member.
 - a) A **single membership** may invite one non-BLPH 'Guest' to a concert, **BUT ONLY if sufficient tickets are available AND the 'Guest' joins BLPH prior to the date of ticket purchase by completing a BLPH Membership Form and paying current Club membership dues.**
[DETAILS: This is in line with the PHiP Guidelines that state: "...single memberships are eligible for two tickets, provided a member of the local Parrot Head Club uses the second ticket."]
 - b) A **family membership** of more than two [2] will be able to earn ticket eligibility for **each** family member.
[DETAILS: This is in line with the PHiP Guidelines that state: "A family membership is eligible for 2 tickets." and "In the event that there are 4 active members in a household, provisions will be made by the local Club President for additional disbursement of tickets to these members."]
 - c) **Family memberships** who cannot use their entire ticket allotment, may apply the same single membership rule **[a) above]** for their unused tickets.
 - d) An invited 'Guest' is allowed only one opportunity to use a BLPH Club Ticket. Also, the 'Guest' is required to sit with the BLPH member to whom the tickets have been assigned.
 - e) Once BLPH club tickets have been assigned, the member responsible for the ticket[s] **MUST** pay the ticket cost to BLPH regardless of any change in the status of their individual or family's/guest's concert attendance. Refusal to comply will result in the member's ticket eligibility being revoked for that year's concert.
[DETAILS: In other words, if you are assigned four (4) tickets for your family, you are responsible for payment of 4 tickets. In the same vane, if you are assigned two (2) tickets {one (1) for yourself and one (1) for a 'Guest'} you are responsible for payment of both tickets assigned to you.]

6. BLPH members eligible for tickets will receive first priority for club tickets/seats. Tickets purchased by a BLPH member and an accompanying non-BLPH 'Guest', those seats will be allocated after the BLPH members seats have been assigned.
7. Members who belong to multiple Clubs may purchase Club Tickets from only one (1) Club, and must designate which Club prior to BLPH's acceptance of Member's ticket deposit.

PARTICIPATION IN BLPH ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS

[PARTICIPATION TIME LINE: Calendar year – January thru December]

On an annual basis, the minimum Participation in Activities/Events eligibility requirement is broken into **two [2] categories**. The categories of activities/events are detailed below. A member **MUST MEET BOTH** of the categories to be considered an active member. If a member does not fulfill **BOTH** of these category eligibility requirements within the time-line established above, he/she will not be eligible for concert tickets.

- A) **Attendance at four [4]** of our regularly scheduled monthly social phunctions **with a canned good/humane society contribution and/or Goodwill/Salvation Army/Lafayette Urban Ministry [LUM]/etc. donation;**
OR

A payment of \$10.00 per member/per social phunction up to \$40.00 per member.

[DETAILS: The purpose of the monetary payment is to allow those members not able or within the vicinity to attend four [4] regularly scheduled social phunctions within the year, to be able to meet Category A. The payment is set at \$10.00/per member/per meeting up to \$40.00 per member for it to equate the amount of time, energy, involvement, and dollars of those members who have made the commitment to be involved.]

- B) **Participation/assistance in three [3] or more** of the following charity, environmental, or community activities/events;

OR

Sponsorship of \$10 per single membership, \$25 per family membership/per activity/event, unless the sponsoring agency requires a minimum pledge amount for the specified activity/event.

[DETAILS: The purpose of the monetary payment is to allow those members not able or within the vicinity to attend/participate in three [3] charity, environmental, or community activities/events, to be able to meet Category B. The payment is set as noted above for it to equate the amount of time, energy, involvement, and dollars of those members who have made the commitment to be involved.]

Charity Activities/Events currently include but are not limited to:

- 'MoD WalkAmerica';
- 'Bark in the Park,' if BLPH opts to participate on an annual basis;
- Alzheimer's Association Annual 'Memory Walk';
- Humane Society 'Strike Out Suffering Bowl-A-Thon';
- Any or all of the four [4] annual highway cleanups;
- Assistance with and/or participation in the annual Christmas Parade, if BLPH opts to submit and entry in a given year;
- BLPH sponsored visits to retirement homes; or
- Participation/sponsorship/payment to any other charity event so long as you recognize your participation/sponsorship/payment under BLPH [receipt required].
